Who are we?

The Bay Area Asian Sports (BAAS) Dragons is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, whose mission is to provide a structure under which Asian boys and girls can develop physically, psychologically and socially through athletics.

The organization was formed in the year 2000, with seven youth basketball teams (boys and girls). Since then, it has grown to over 250 families and 30 teams, with players ranging from the 2nd to 12th grades, and has quickly become one of the largest Asian basketball organizations in Northern California.

The organization is entirely volunteer-driven, from the Executive Board to the coaches and team managers. It secures gym space for practices, organizes an annual tournament which draws participants from all over the state, forms new teams each year, runs clinics, camps and basketball leagues during the summer, and sponsors social activities and fundraising events.

What are we trying to accomplish?

With the goal of strengthening bonds among our organizational members as well as the surrounding community and other organizations, BAAS is embarking on a long and ambitious journey -- the building of a sports community center.

We envision that this facility will serve as a home base from which past and present players can come together through sports, to mentor each other to reach new heights, and to inspire the next generation of youth.

Families will have a place to continue building community long after their children have finished competing as players. New programs can be introduced and existing programs expanded, to strengthen and widen our network of families.
